Insects of Micronesia To Be Resurrected Soon

The well-known series, *Insects of Micronesia*, is being published again beginning with an issue scheduled to appear by the end of 1991. It will contain papers on 3 families of Diptera not previously treated for Micronesia: Dolichopodidae, Bombyliidae, and Tethinidae.

The editors will be sending out a letter of query to all persons who had been listed as participants or potential participants in order to gauge whether or not it will be feasible for them to complete their particular families within a 2, 3, or 5-year period. There will be a time limit within which all authors will be able to submit manuscripts. After that time, the series will be concluded. It is hoped that funding will be obtained to produce a summary checklist of all the insects of Micronesia after the journal series has been completed.
